

June 14, 2022 Minutes

The Coffee County Legislative Body met June 14, 2022 in a regular scheduled meeting at the Coffee County Administrative Plaza at 6:00 PM.

Sheriff Chad Partin proclaimed the meeting open for business.

Ronnie Hollaway Pastor from the Tullahoma Church of God gave the Invocation and Claude Morse led the Pledge to the Flag.

Twenty members were present for the meeting with Helen Debellis being absent.

Mayor Cordell requested to amend the agenda by adding School Budget Amendments under 11i with the other budget amendments and under 11k adding feasibility study of Animal Control. Motion made by Kraft and seconded by Ray to approve the agenda as amended. The motion was approved with 19 yes votes and Miller voted no.

Public comments were held.

Motion made by Ray and seconded by Hollandsworth to approve the minutes of the previous meeting. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Mayor Cordell presented a Proclamation for Eagle Scout Kaitlyn Brown.

Motion made by Kraft and seconded by Hollandsworth to approve the following notaries as listed: Stacy Barrett, Vicki Basham, Stephanie Gail Basham, Tara Boles, Kim W. Bush, Patricia L. Motion made by Hunt and seconded by Orrick for the adoption of Resolution 2022-17 to amend Coffee County Zoning Resolution 2006-39 to Rezone Properties on Map 093, Parcel 84.;00; of Evans Lumber Co., LLC. Located on 3781 New

Tullahoma Highway from C-2, General Commercial District to M-1, General Industrial District. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Tim Stubblefield and seconded by Crabtree to approve changes to the Coffee County Personnel Manual Harassment Policy by inserting on page 16 in the second paragraph "Complaints presented by employees of EMS shall be handled by the Ambulance Authority and complaints presented by employees of the Communication Center (911) will be handled through the Communication Center Board." And delete the paragraph of Administrative Closings on page 22. The motion was approved with 19 yes votes and Orrick abstained.

Motion made by Bryan and seconded by Orrick to approve the ratification of Private ACT Private Chapter No. 53, an ACT relative to an entertainment even fee for certain events held in Coffee County. The motion was approved with 19 yes votes and Hollandsworth voted no.

Motion made by Crabtree and seconded by Cunningham for the adoption of Resolution 2022-18 approving Omnia Partners, Public Sector, as a Purchasing Cooperative Option for Coffee County, Tennessee. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Hollandsworth and seconded by Kraft for the adoption of Resolution 2022-19 approving Lease Agreement with Coffee County Historical Society. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Kraft and seconded by Duncan for the adoption of Resolution 2022-20 approving lease agreement with Haven of Hope. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Crabtree and seconded by Orrick to approve the proposed ARP Projects. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Orrick and seconded by Crabtree for the adoption of Resolution 2022-21 to extend existing lease and enter into a new Ten (e110) year lease with the Coffee County Veterans Association. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Orrick and seconded by Hobbs for the approval of the following budget amendments: #151-2022-016 General Debt Service, #152-2022-017 Rural Debt Service, #171-2022-18 EDU Education Capital Projects, #171-2022-19 RCP Rural Capital Projects Fund, #131-2022-20 Highway/Public Works Fund, #110-2022-21 Ambulance Service Fund and #101-2022-22 General Fund. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Motion made by Orrick and seconded by Crabtree for the approval of the following school budget amendments: #141-2022-03 General Purpose School Fund, #141-2022-4 General Purpose School Fund, #141-2022-5 General Purpose School Fund #141-2022-6 General Purpose School Fund and #143-2022-1 Food Service. The motion was approved with 20 yes votes.

Commissioner Bryan presented the Proposed Budget July 1, 2022 through June 30, 2023.

Discussion was held on the Animal Control facility.

There being no further business the County Legislative Body adjourned.
