The Coffee County Legislative Body met July 9, 2019 in a regular scheduled meeting at the Coffee County Administrative Plaza at 6:00 PM.

Chief Deputy Sheriff Frank Watkins proclaimed the meeting open for business.

Amanda Fuller from Sojourners' Fellowship Church gave the Invocation and Jackie Duncan led the Pledge to the Flag.

Eighteen members were present for the meeting. Todd Crockett and Bobby Bryan were absent.

State Representative Rush Bricken along with Deputy Comptroller Jason Mumpower, Deputy Chief of Staff Jennifer Pfeiffer, Legislative Liaison Hayden Pendergrass and Senior Auditor Melodie Hodges presented Mayor Cordell and the Commission a Certificate of Clean Audit for Coffee County.

Chairman Cordell requested a motion to approve the agenda. Motion made by Kraft and seconded by Debellis to approve the agenda. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Bridgett Renea Morrison, Cindy L. Wendling and Christy Ann Wray. The motion was approved with 18 yes votes.

Motion made by Miller and seconded by Kraft to reappoint Missy Deford and appoint Barbara Buckner replacing Mark Kelly to the Ambulance Authority. The motion was approved with 16 yes votes. Deford and Buckner abstained.

Motion made by Debellis and seconded by Hunt for the adoption of Resolution #2019-17 to amend Coffee County zoning resolution #2006-39 to rezone property on map 047, parcel 058.01 of David and Gloria Brown located at 8220 McMinnville Highway from C-1, rural center district to C-2 general commercial district. The motion was approved with 17 yes votes and Taylor abstained.

Motion made by Taylor and seconded by Ray to adjourn.
